**To our Guests:** We are happy to have you worshipping with us this morning. We know that visiting a new church can be awkward. We want you to feel as comfortable as possible. We ask that food, coffee, and other beverages not be brought into the auditorium. Remember to silence all electronic devices as soon as you enter the auditorium.

The last two rows of seating are reserved for families with small children.

**Preparation for Worship:** It is appropriate for those entering into the place of the corporate worship of God to do so joyfully and reverently.
